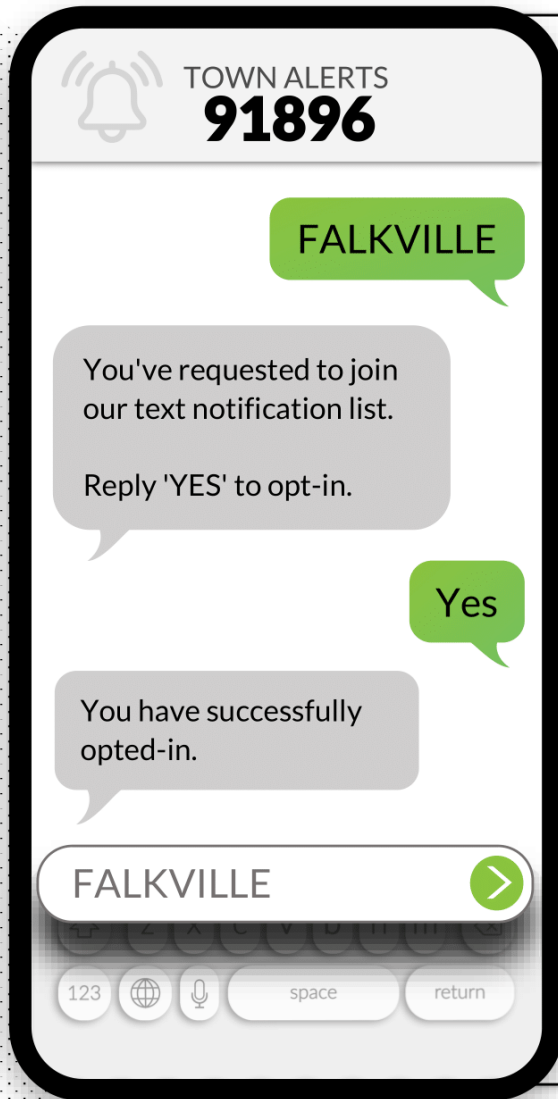

DID YOU KNOW?.....

DO YOU KNOW THE BURN RULES?

If you are planning on doing any burning, please stop by the Town Hall for a burn permit. The last day to burn is **April 30th, 2023**. **No burning is allowed from May 1 to October 31 of each year.**

Here is a list of conditions for burning.

- ~ Only clean (**no fuel of non-vegetative refuse added**) vegetation may be burned.
- ~ It must be burned on the property from which it is generated.
- ~ The burning must be at least **500 feet** from the nearest occupied dwelling and a distance from any road that would prevent visibility issues from the smoke.
- ~ The fire should be started between **8 a.m. and 3 p.m.** No vegetation should be added to the fire after 3 p.m.
- ~ Burn permit is required.
